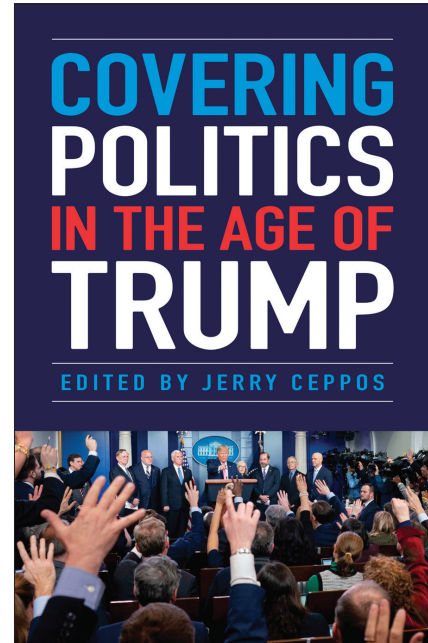

Like politics, journalism has been turned topsy-turvy by the presidency of Donald Trump. *Covering Politics in the Age of Trump* takes a wide-ranging view of the relationship between the forty-fifth president and the Fourth Estate.
